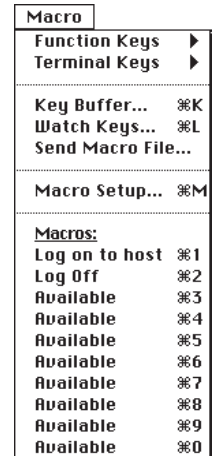
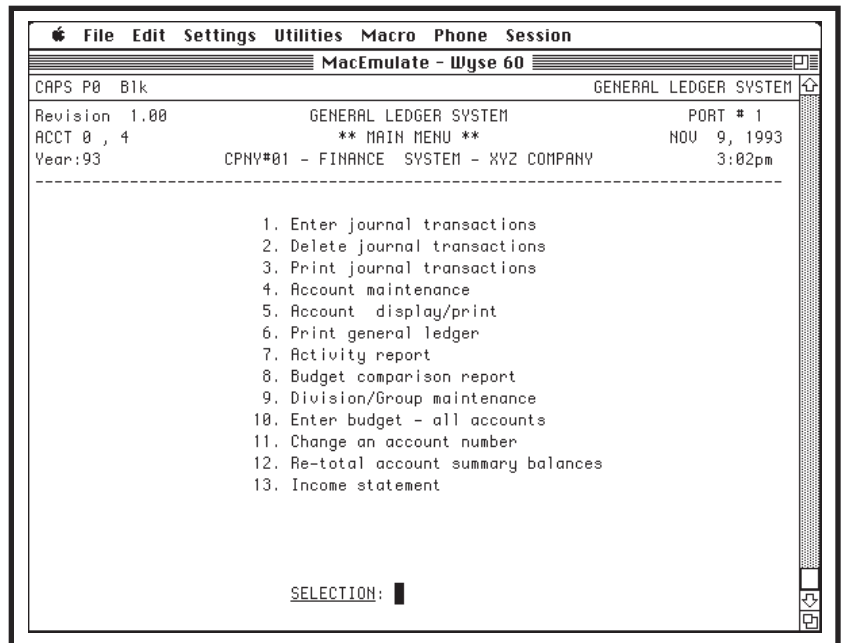

- 80 or 132 columns, 24 or 25 lines

- Use mouse clicks instead of arrow keys
- Store up to 20 macros per settings file
- Create macros automatically by watching keystrokes
- Buffered keyboard (type and edit text before sending)
- Send pictures of screen to printer, file, or clipboard
- Tabulate, print, and edit text files
- Supports Apple's Communications Toolbox:
 - File transfers
 - Connections (such as ASDP, TCP Telnet, etc.)
 - Connect thru serial port cards

Questions & Answers

Will it work with my system?

MacEmulate will work on any computer that can accept one of the supported terminal types (Wyse, TeleVideo, Hazeltine, etc.). It does not matter what type of computer or operating system you have. MacEmulate just takes the place of a real terminal. It has been used with a wide variety of operating systems including Unix, Linux, Xenix, VAX, PICK, SuperDOS, Alpha Micro, Basic 4, IRIS, HP, and many others.

How do I make the connection?

You can connect over the network using the TCP/IP Telnet protocol. If your system uses serial ports (RS232), all you need is the standard Macintosh modem cable and a gender changer. This lets you connect the Mac's communication port to any cable coming from the host computer that can be used by a terminal. To connect to a modem directly, you use the same cable without the gender changer.

How does it work?

MacEmulate is a software application that makes the Mac imitate the functions of a terminal. No other software or hardware is required (except the cabling). You start MacEmulate as you would any application, and it brings up a window that does everything a real terminal can do, and more. It's that simple!

Why should I use MacEmulate instead of a terminal?

MacEmulate let's your Mac double as a terminal. It makes sense to use one piece of equipment to do multiple tasks. MacEmulate can save you the costs of buying, repairing and replacing terminals and can free up your desk space. Some of our satisfied users say they plan to use MacEmulate on every Macintosh they own.
